#### WHAT IT SAYS IN THE VOTING MACHINE:

Shall the Board of Education construct additions, renovations and improvements to the Westhill High School, Onondaga Hill Middle School, and Cherry Road Elementary School, including improvements to exterior athletic facilities, fields and courts, parking and sidewalks and construct renovations and improvements to the Walberta Park School and Bus Garage including, for all of the foregoing, construction, renovations, site improvements, original furnishings, fixtures and equipment, architectural fees, and all other necessary costs incidental to such work and expend therefore a total sum not to exceed \$29,800,000, which is estimated to be the total maximum cost thereof, and to pay for the project by using \$950,000 from the Capital Reserve approved by the District's voters on May 8, 2007 and by the levy of a tax which is hereby voted for the Project in the amount of \$28,850,000, subject to the State Aid available, which shall be levied and collected in annual installments in such years and in such amounts as may be determined by the Board of Education and in anticipation of the collection of such tax, bonds and notes of the District are hereby authorized to be issued at one time, or from time to time, in the principal amount not to exceed \$28,850,000, and a tax is hereby voted to pay the interest on said obligations when due?

#### WALBERTA PARK SCHOOL

##### Additions

(None)

##### Renovations

- Full-Day Kindergarten Classrooms
- Library/Computer Rooms
- Special Areas (special education, AIS reading, speech, ELL, and OT/PT)
- Art Classroom

##### Infrastructure/site work

Add security entrance, replace windows, pave west parking lot, repair loading dock, replace gas and sanitary mains, replace clock and sound systems, and electrical upgrades.

#### CHERRY ROAD SCHOOL

##### Additions

- Seven Classrooms for Additional Grade Level
- Music Classroom
- Cafeteria/Kitchen

##### Renovations

- Library/Computer Rooms
- Special Areas (speech, ELL, and OT/PT)
- Art Classroom
- Physical Education Office

##### Infrastructure/site work

Replace classroom sinks/cabinets, renovate sidewalk/add curbs for parking area, renovate bathrooms (1st/2nd floors), asbestos abatement, replace ceilings (1st/2nd floors), pave bus drop-off and parking area, and replace storm and sanitary mains.

#### ONONDAGA HILL MIDDLE SCHOOL

##### Additions

- Library/Computer Rooms
- Industrial Arts/Technology Classrooms
- Bathrooms/Concessions/Storage Building for Athletic Fields

##### Renovations

- Art Classrooms (2 rooms)
- Locker Rooms (boys' and girls')
- Athletic Fields (develop recently purchased land, with parking areas to be accessed via a new entrance on Velasko Road)

##### Infrastructure/site work

Gym upgrades: wall pads, backboards, and painting; replace wooden exterior siding; replace three exterior doors; replace 1960s air handling units, replace electrical service, upgrade plumbing fixtures and pumps; replace exhaust fans; replace clock systems; upgrade fire alarm, smoke detection, and emergency lighting systems.

#### WESTHILL HIGH SCHOOL

##### Additions

- Music Classrooms (band and chorus)

##### Renovations

- Athletics (resurface track and install synthetic turf on main playing field)
- Cafeteria/Kitchen

##### Infrastructure/site work

Replace windows in gym and cafeteria, pave east parking lot and exit to Onondaga Boulevard, upgrade stage lighting, and replace sanitary main.

#### BUS GARAGE

##### Infrastructure/site work

- Upgrade mechanical/HVAC and electrical systems; replace plumbing fixtures, piping and sanitary main.
