SUBJECT: USE OF PARLIAMENTARY PROCEDURE

The Board of Education recognizes the value of adhering to general principles of proper parliamentary procedure for the purpose of conducting Board meetings in an orderly and democratic fashion. Therefore, the business of the Board of Education shall be conducted to the extent that is reasonable, lawful and practicable to do so in accordance with the authoritative principles of parliamentary procedure as found in the latest edition of Robert's Rules of Order. In no event, however, shall the Board permit a rigid devotion to Robert's Rules and the myriad variations and applications to those Rules to be utilized or invoked by any member of the Board, or by any other person, to obstruct the will of the Board majority (within the limits of applicable law) or to disrupt the expeditious and orderly conduct of Board meetings.
