

# Proposal to the Class of 2011

## Goal:

1. Convert the Junior Prom into the Junior Ball
2. Change the set up of the Senior Ball and make it a Senior Night Dinner-Dance.
3. Eliminate Senior Breakfast and use Senior Dinner-Dance to give awards and watch senior video.

## Currently:

- The Junior's traditionally hold the Junior Prom in early to mid May.
- The Senior Ball is held the first Friday in June, the same day as the senior breakfast.
- Each class raises money to help offset the cost of the Junior Prom, Senior Breakfast, Senior Ball, as well as other cost associated with graduation.
- Senior class has traditionally paid for all the flowers at graduation.
- Estimated financial expenditures for the class of 2011:
  - Junior Prom – \$7,500
  - Senior Ball – \$10,000
  - Senior Breakfast - \$2,200
  - Flowers for Graduation - \$1,000
  - Other Various Expenses - \$1,000

Expenses are off set by various fundraisers throughout the classes 4 years in high school. The senior class raises money through an annual talent show in the fall and boy's basketball concession of all home games.

## Proposal:

1. Restructure the Junior Prom and make it the Junior Ball, which would be open to all juniors and dates from within and without the school.
2. Eliminate the Senior Ball and have a Senior Night Dinner-Dance. This night is for class members only.
3. The Dinner-Dance will consist of presentation of awards, a senior video, DJ, Dance Floor, and a sit down dinner. Elimination of Senior Breakfast (Use money to off set cost of Dinner-Dance)
4. Eliminate the pressures of: Dates, Money, Tuxedo, etc . . .
5. The Dinner and Dance is to become a night for seniors only. Your last chance to be all together.

Senior Night will be:

1. Semi-Formal (Suit and tie for the men, and dresses for the women - NO TUXEDOS)
2. Open to all Seniors
3. Dinner w/awards and presentations
4. Video Montage of the Seniors 4 years in High School
5. Still have PTO run and "After the Dinner" event

Possible variations may include:

- Presentation of Most Outstanding Senior Boy and Girl
- Distribution of Yearbooks
- Selected Class Speaker
- Any other assorted ideas that are discussed throughout the year
