OHMS Students Learn about Healthy Choices

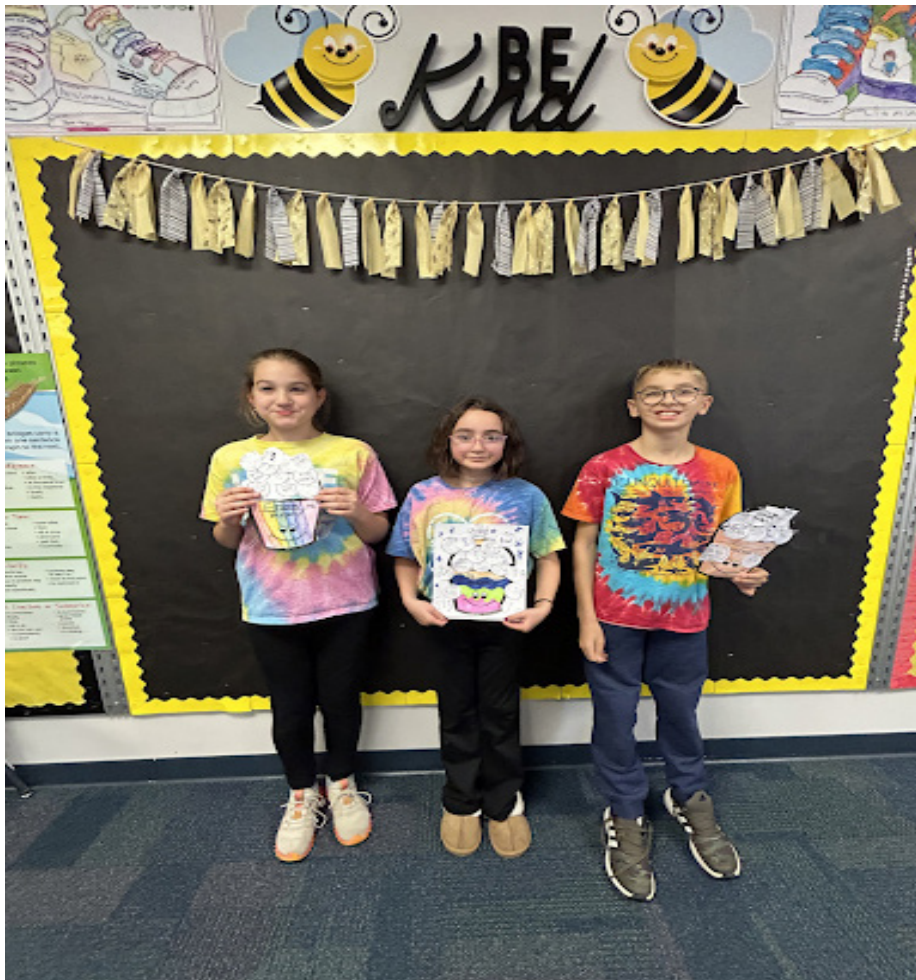

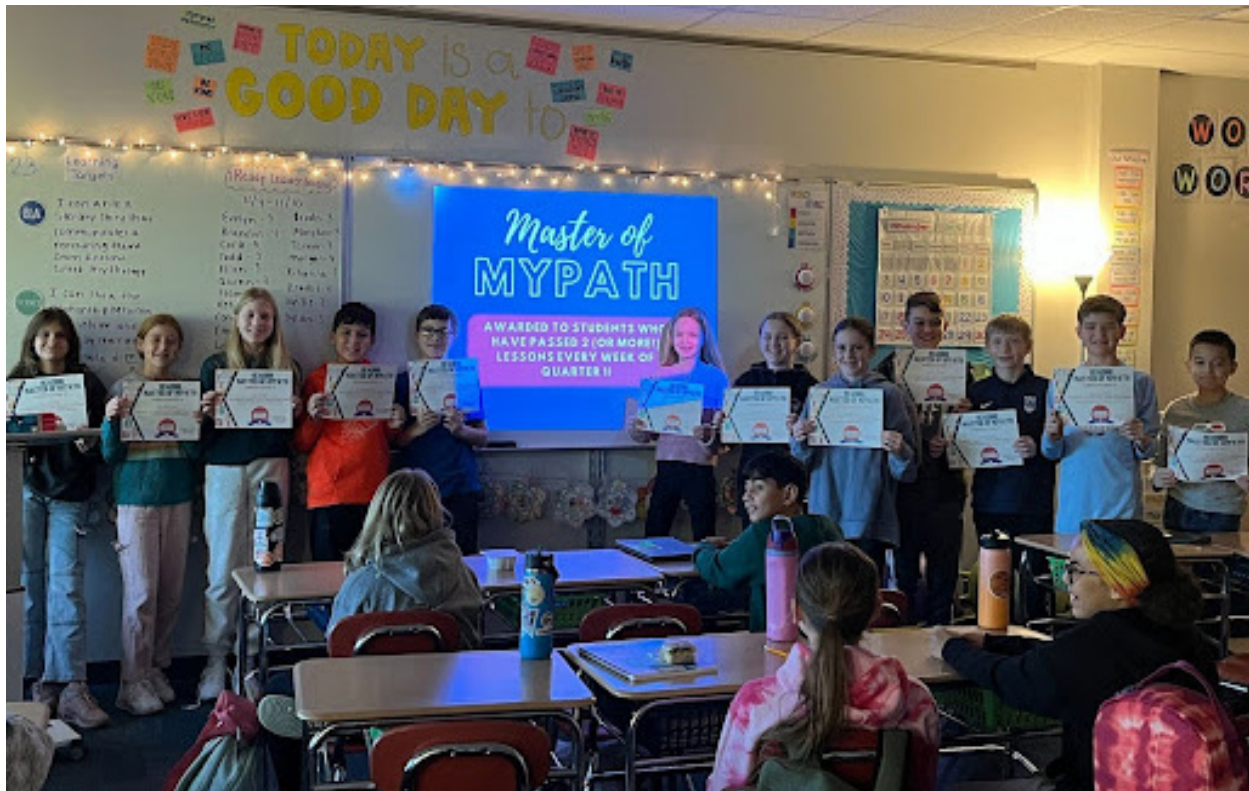

 - Physical & immunization records (can be sent in later after the 5 year check up)
3. Please fill out the packet completely and return it to us between March 3rd and March 7th. You can mail it, drop it off or email it. There will not be an in-person registration day.
4. A kindergarten orientation will be held for students and parents on Tuesday, August 26, 2025. More information will be forthcoming.
5. Once your child is registered, you will receive a link to sign your child up for our kindergarten screening which will take place at the end of June or very beginning of July, specific date to be determined. Every incoming kindergartner must be screened to enter school. Screening helps us make class placements and plan for instruction to best meet children's needs.
